6. What can I do for my club?

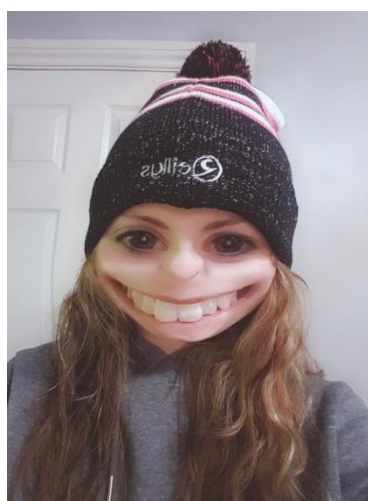
Holloway Gaels has been busy building friendships for over 25 years. Please help your club out by:
